



PETITION FORM TO TAKE COURSES REMOTELY – FALL 2020

At TWU, community is part of the educational experience. Faculty-student and student-student interactions in the classroom are a very important part of the academic process. Every precaution is being taken to ensure that classrooms are safe for students and faculty in the fall of 2020. However, TWU also recognizes that some students fall into a high risk category due to COVID-19 and should consider taking courses remotely. It is also possible that a TWU student cannot comply with TWU requirements to wear a mask for medical reasons. This form is exclusively for these two groups. Members of the TWU student body who are active athletes or are living in campus housing are not eligible to apply to take courses remotely.

Students applying to take courses remotely will be expected to join in-seat classroom meetings via Microsoft Teams and will be subject to the same attendance policy as students who are in-seat. Students approved for remote learning are encouraged to discuss with their advisor the possibility of enrolling in fully online courses for part or all of their course load.
