



Educational Partnership Award

The Educational Partnership Award was established to grow the partnership between TWU's Education students and our Community Partners.

Award Qualifications:

1. Student must be a graduate from a high school in a primary or state approved partner with TWU.
2. The student must be declaring an education major that is an identified high needs area.
3. The student must have an ACT composite score of 21 or SAT equivalent of 1080 and a minimum high school GPA of 3.0.

Award Criteria:

1. Awarded to qualified new freshman who declare Education as his/her major.
2. The student will be awarded an additional \$2,500 scholarship per year (total value \$10,000) per the above qualifications are met and the student remains an Education major with a minimum university GPA of 2.5.
3. The recipient must work with either the Education Department and/or Community Partner(s) 45 hours each semester (3 hours per week) as determined by the Education faculty.
4. Failure to work the required hours will result in the loss of this scholarship for the student.
